2nd Annual Fifth Avenue Fest August 2

St. Cloud's second annual 5th Avenue Fest will be from noon-4 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 2, a celebration of the thoroughfare's heritage as a significant dining, entertainment and business center; historic residential district; link to the South Side/University neighborhood and home of St. Cloud's oldest public park. The event will highlight fun and food, spanning historic Fifth Avenue from Pioneer Place to Barden Park and featuring local musicians, walking tours of Downtown landmarks led by historian Bill Morgan, photos and characters from the old neighborhood, stops at an extended Farmers' Market and the SCSU Community Garden; children's activities, including skateboarding events at City Hall and a walking museum in Barden Park and much, much more. The event is once again planned in conjunction with the celebration "Takin' It to The Streets" outdoor concert near Pioneer Place in Downtown St. Cloud beginning at 6 p.m.
